

Venmo Comes to St. Barnabas

Venmo is a smartphone and tablet payment app that allows users to transfer funds to other users, including organizations, such as St. Barnabas. As background, Venmo is part of Pay Pal, Inc., which was spun-off from eBay in 2015, as a separate public company.

Venmo can be used to transfer funds by a variety of methods, but if initiated from a bank account or with a debit card, neither the sender or the receiver pays a service charge.

To set up a Venmo account, either go to venmo.com on a computer, or download the app from the store on your smartphone or tablet, and follow the sign-up instructions.

To send funds to St. Barnabas, log into the Venmo app on your mobile device, and press the icon with a pen and dollar sign. On the next screen, type the username @StBarnabas-Church, enter the amount you wish to transfer, type what the funds are for (pledge, day of change, social event), and hit "PAY." All this information is private, visible only to Financial Administrator Mary Beth Dauner.

Next time, @StBarnabas-Church should show up on your list of "TOP PEOPLE." To initiate other fund transfers, just select @StBarnabas-Church from your list of "TOP PEOPLE" and follow the instructions.
